

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What does the league provide to the players?

The league provides a team jersey, team hat, and socks.

What color pants do I purchase?

Your coach will tell you what color pants to buy once you are on a team.

When will I know what team and coach my child will have?

The skill assessments for Coaches Pitch and Minors are on Saturday, Feb. 7 and Ozone Majors on Sunday, Feb. 8. Teams are selected on those days, and your coach will be calling you in the next day or two. T-Ball practice begins on Tues, Feb. 17. Your coach will be contacting you that weekend.

Can I be on the same team as my friend for carpooling?

A draft is conducted in Coaches Pitch, Minors, Ozone Majors, and Dixie Boys. Per League rules we do not honor these requests in these leagues.

What days do I practice?

The practice schedule is not completed until registration is over.

Once your head coach calls you, your coach will know the practice schedule.

What days do I have games?

There are not certain days that games will be held for each league.

Games will be Monday – Saturday.

What happens on Opening Ceremonies?

Team and Individual pictures; Ceremony that last 1 hr – introducing all teams, sponsors, coaches, board members, and fundraiser. Games start at 11:00.

What equipment does the league supply for my child?

The league supplies bats, helmets and catcher's gear.
