**Blythewood Baseball Tobacco Policy** – All Richland County Recreation Commission facilities, including outdoor facilities, are now tobacco free. Tobacco usage is only allowed in designated areas as determined by the Commission. The designated area at Blythewood Park is the parking lot.

**Uniforms** -The league provides a team jersey, team hat, and socks. Your coach will inform you what color pants to buy once a team color is designated.

**Baseball Equipment** -The league supplies bats, helmets and catcher's gear. You are required to bring a baseball glove. You can bring bat, helmets and catchers gear if you have. If your child out grows their baseball equipment, BBL accepts any and all equipment donations, Thank you.

**Why do I have to volunteer in the concession stand?**

The concession stand is BBL's second largest method of income to support our baseball league. Without the funds generated from the concession stand the registration fee per child would have to increase by a substantial amount (see note below) possibly making it unaffordable for many families to participate in baseball in Blythewood.

**We would like to say thank you to all of our sponsors.**

Registration cost is \$80.00; \$70.00 - T Ball

It costs the league per child \$120.00 – uniforms, equipment, umpires

Our sponsors, fundraisers, concession stand and volunteers make up the difference for each child to play baseball.

**Skill assessments** - Coaches Pitch & Minors are on Sat, Feb. 6; Ozone Majors on Sun, Feb. 7. Teams are selected on those days, and your coach will be calling you in the next day or two. T-Ball practice begins on Tues, Feb. 16. Your coach will be contacting you that weekend.

**“Dixie Youth Baseball”** recommends an Annual Player draft seeking a more equitable method of assigning players to a league team for Coaches Pitch, Minors, Ozone Majors, and Dixie Boys. Per DYB draft recommendations and BBL League rules, BBL does not honor requests to be on a certain team with a coach and/or teammate, with exception for Head Coach/ Sponsor pairings.

**Practice schedule** - is not completed until registration is over and the quantity of teams is determined. Once registration is completed and the draft is conducted, your child's head coach will call you and give you a practice schedule.

**Practices and Games** will be random from Mon – Sat. (There could be Sunday practices.) There are no specific days assigned to each league.

**Opening Ceremonies** - Team and Individual pictures; Ceremony will last 1 hr – introducing all teams, sponsors, coaches, board members, and fundraiser. Games start at 11:00. Team and Individual pictures may start at 7:30 am until approximately 3:00 pm. A picture schedule will be distributed to the head coaches once the game schedule is set for opening day.

**No parking at the library.** The library can tow your vehicle if you park there.
